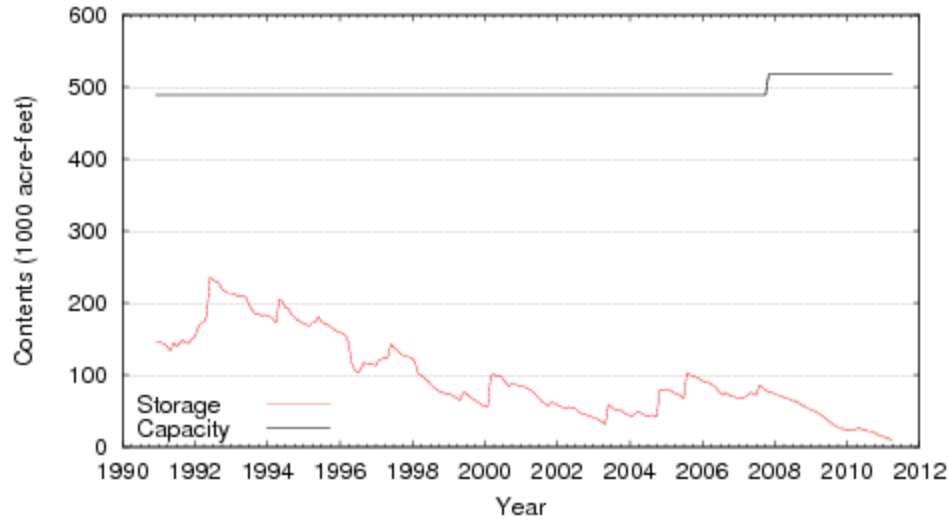

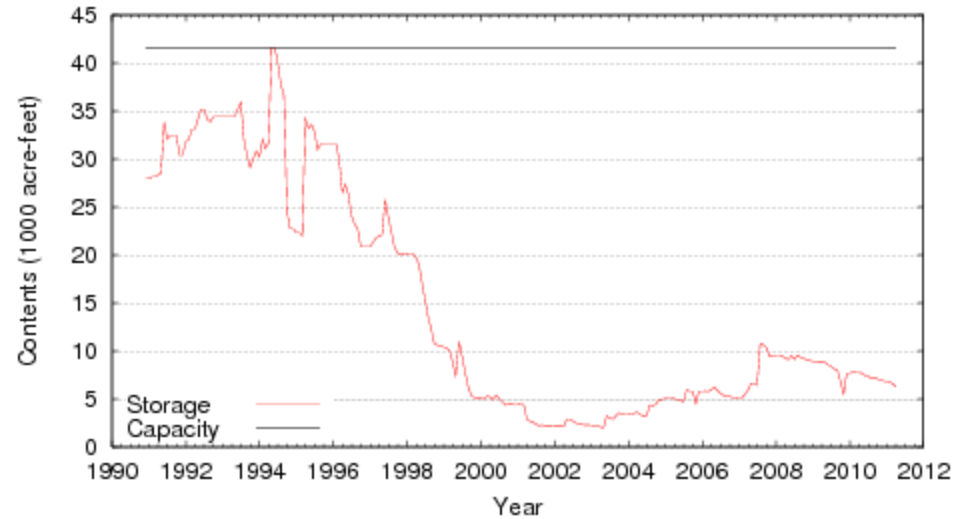
## E.V. Spence Reservoir – Coke County

Conservation Capacity: 0.517 Million acre-ft



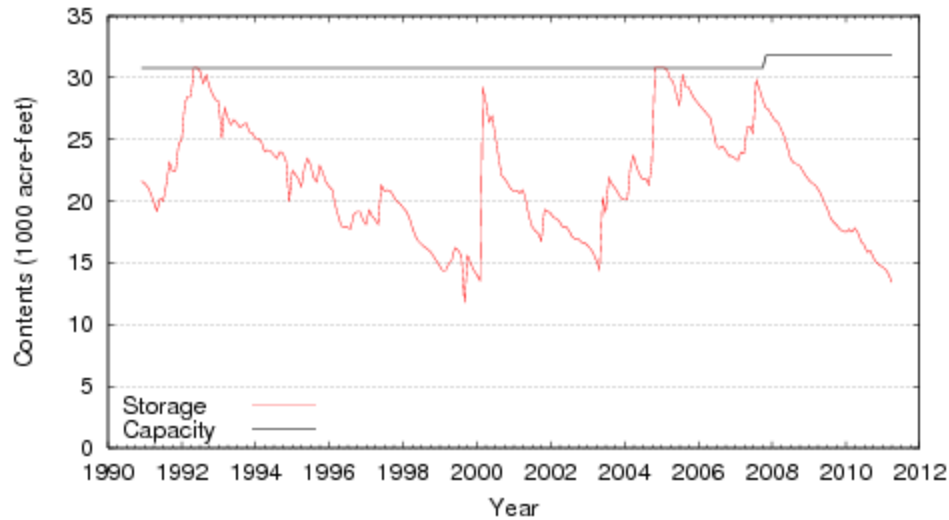
## Champion Ck Reservoir – Mitchell County

Conservation Capacity: 41618 acre-ft



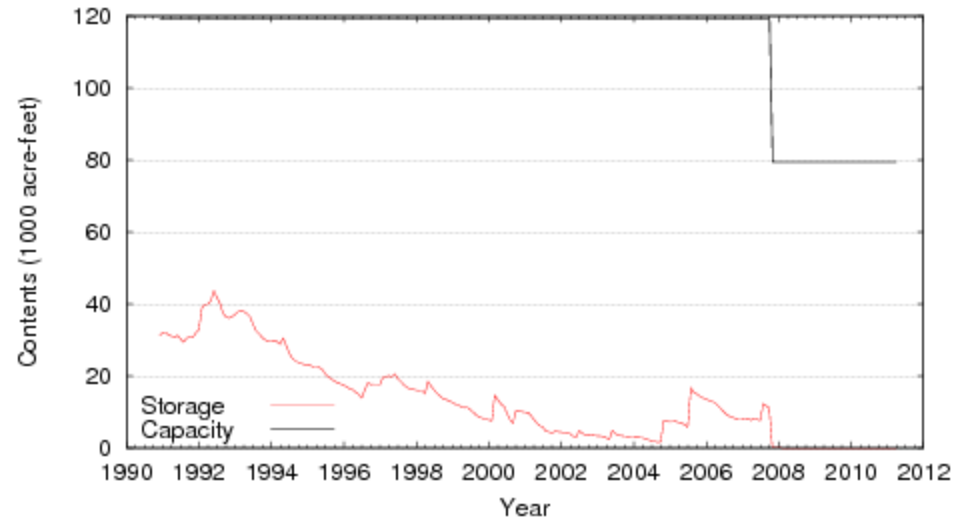
## Lake Colorado City – Mitchell County

Conservation Capacity: 31793 acre-ft



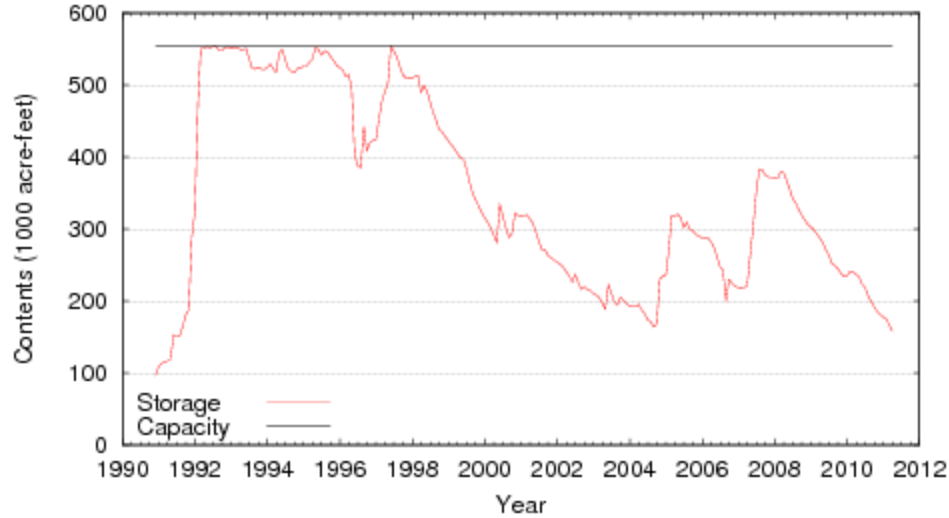
## OC Fisher Reservoir – Tom Green County

Conservation Capacity: 79483 acre-ft



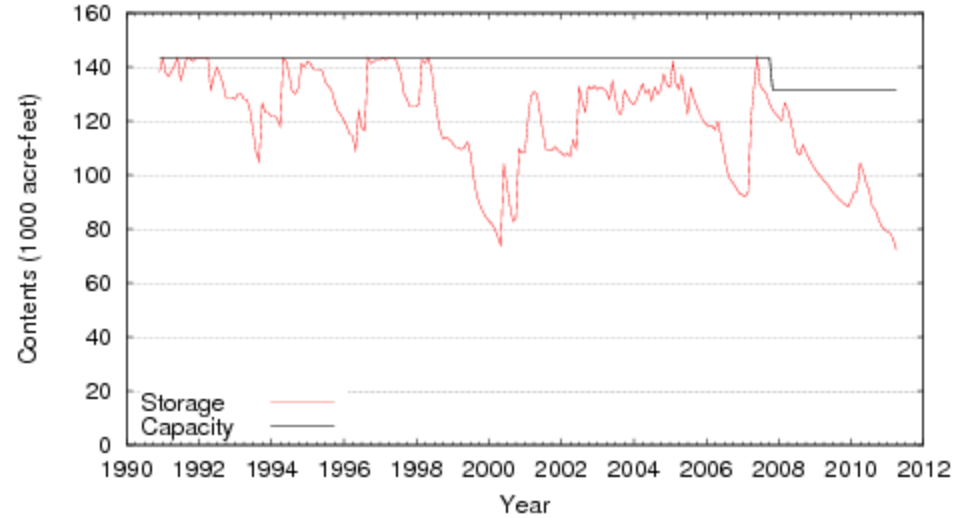
## OH Ivie Reservoir – Concho County
