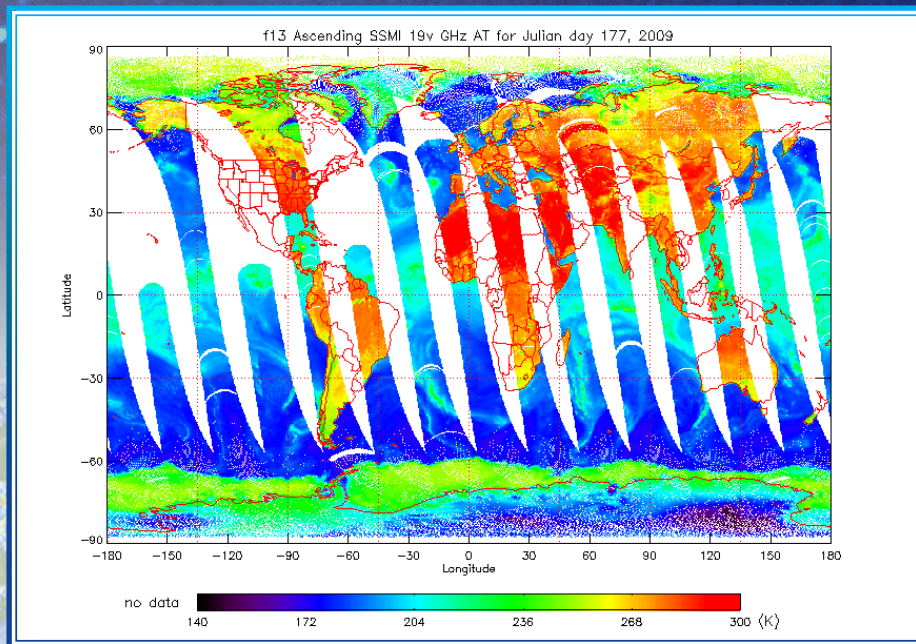

SSMI(S) CLIMATE DATA RECORD SPECIFICATIONS

- Global Coverage
- Resolution varies by Channel (14 x 16 km, 45 x 70 km)
- 101 Minutes Per Orbit
- 1987–Present
- Updated Daily

- Navy-NESDIS Special Sensor Microwave Imager/Sounder [SSMI(S)]
- Antenna Temperature

SOME USES OF THE SSMI(S) CLIMATE DATA RECORD

- Input into Precipitation Products
- Determining Sea Surface Winds
- Calculating Sea Ice Extent and Snow Cover
- Long-term Global Climate Applications
- Estimating Cloud Liquid Water
