A car was swept off a causeway and into a drainage ditch in Middlesex County, resulting in one drowning. Extensive flooding occurred in the lackson and Wicksburg metropolitan areas as severs and low lying areas could not discharge the outtimosity accumulating rainfall. Barricades went up as trets flooded, Many mindr auto accidents occurred along with shalled vehicles because of high water. Water also flooded date roads.
